Land North of Springfield

The big news is that the Parish Council sold this land just before Christmas. Crocus Homes will be building the 36 homes on the land. They have a website where you can register your interest:

Budget

The Parish Council set a precept of £83,950 for 15/16. This works out at an average of £87 for the year for a band D house. The money is collected by Broadland District Council as part of your Council Tax, and then paid over to the Parish Council. The precept pays for the day-to-day running of Parish Council assets such as most of the village street lights, the Christmas lighting, grasscutting around the village, the Damgate Lane and Beighton Road play areas, the Fletcher Room (Pre-school), the part-time parish clerk and Council cleaner.

The capital monies from the sale of the land can only be used to pay for the

purchase or replacement of assets – buildings, land or equipment.
