# PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

## RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The show will be open to the residents of Acle and surrounding districts.
2. Entries will be received at the School between 8.00 p.m. and 8.45 p.m. on Friday, 12th September and between 9.30 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on Saturday, 13th September.
3. Completed entry forms and all items you are entering must be checked with the Reception Steward BEFORE booking in with the Entry Steward. PLEASE NOTE ONLY ONE PERSON PER ENTRY FORM. Additional entry forms will be available at the show, if required.
4. An exhibitor may enter only one exhibit in each class. In the Handicraft Section and Photographic Section, exhibits must not previously have been entered in the Acle Society Show.
5. All produce and flowers must be grown by the exhibitor, except for Flower Arrangements. Pot Plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for at least three months.
6. Exhibitors must provide their own plates, vases etc. and the Society accepts no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to them. Bakery exhibits should be suitably protected.
7. Exhibitors' numbers must be affixed to plates, dishes or bottles etc., **not** on lids, cling film or other coverings.
8. Prizes will be awarded at the Judges' discretion and will depend upon the number and quality of entries in each class. The Judges' decisions are final.
9. Prizes will be: 40p; 30p and 25p (adults and juniors).
10. Junior entries in Adult Classes: points will **not** count towards Junior Trophies. Child's age **must not be** stated on junior entries entered in adult classes.
11. Cups and trophies to be held by the winners for one year and must be returned to the organisers not later than 1st August, 2015. **All cups to be cleaned prior to handing over.**  
Cups/trophies will be presented at 4.00 p.m. approximately, following which exhibits and prize cards may be removed. The Show will conclude with an auction and it is hoped exhibitors will leave some items for sale to help offset the cost of staging the show. Exhibitors who wish to retain their entries should clearly mark them "Not for sale".

**COOKERY SECTION :** *All exhibits must be home made and covered with easily removable protective material. No fancy tops on jars*

- C5. A dish of Coconut Ice

- C10. 1 Lemon Drizzle cake - to recipe below
- C11. 1 Victoria Sandwich (3 eggs, jam filling)
- C12. 1 Apple Tart
- C13. 1 Cheese & Tomato Quiche
- C14. 4 Fruit Scones
- C15. 1 loaf of Bread (white - machine made)
- C16. 1 jar of Piccalilli
- C17. 1 jar of Chutney
- C18. 1 jar of Pickled Onions / Shallots (no metal lids)
- C19. 1 Bottle of homemade wine; red, white or rosé (not from a kit)
- C20. 1 Bottle of homemade beer.

### **RECIPE** for use in C10

#### *Lemon drizzle cake*

*170gms (6oz) self raising flour*

*170gms (6oz) caster sugar*

*115gms (4oz) butter*

*2 medium eggs, beaten*

*1 lemon (rind and juice)*

#### *Topping-*

*60gms (2oz) granulated sugar, juice of lemon*

#### **METHOD**

- mix butter and caster sugar together, add eggs and lemon rind, then S.R flour
- Pour into a 2lb loaf tin, bake for 45-50 minutes at gas mark 4, 180°C, 350°F
- Topping: Put granulated sugar and lemon juice in a saucepan, warm together, pour mixture over top of cake
